H. ALABAMA LATA-WIDE CALLING PLAN

1 General

The Alabama LATA-Wide Calling Plan is an optional ten-digit calling plan that provides one-way calling for customers in the Butler, Goshen, Grove Hill, Lisman, Needham, and Pennington exchanges to all exchanges within the LATA in which they reside. Under this plan, customers within the Butler, Lisman, Needham, and Pennington exchanges will also be able to call all Millry Telephone Company exchanges.

2 Regulations

- a The LATA-Wide Calling Plan is available to residential and business customers.
- b LATA-Wide calling provides residential customers with the option of subscribing to unlimited calling within their LATA for a flat monthly charge or subscribing to Usage Option Enhanced for a flat monthly rate plus a per minute rate.
- c LATA-Wide calling provides business customers with three usage options for calling within the LATA. Customers will receive a discounted rate when they package this call plan with TDS Long Distance service.
- d The same Lifeline credits that are applied for regular Residential One-Party service will apply for Lifeline customers that choose to subscribe to the LATA-wide call plan.
- e All non-recurring charges are waived for the initial subscription to this plan. A Central Office Connect and Secondary Service Order charge will apply on second and subsequent call plan changes.
- f The LATA-Wide Unlimited Voice Plan provides unlimited minutes of use for residential voice service only. If it is determined that usage is not consistent with residential voice applications, such as for Internet access services, commercial facsimile or auto-dialing, permanent call forwarding, three-way calling, resale, telemarketing, or other non-residential uses, Butler Telephone Company may immediately suspend LATA-Wide Calling service and move the customer to One-Party service as listed in Section 3. The customer must then select a Long Distance Carrier for intraLATA calling.

L. <u>DUAL PARTY RELAY SERVICE SURCHARGE</u>

General

Alabama Code Section 37-1-80.2 authorizes the Alabama Public Service Commission ("APSC") to impose a surcharge on each access line of each customer of the local exchange companies operating in Alabama to fund the Dual Party Relay System. The Dual Party Relay System ("System") allows a deaf or hearing-impaired person to communicate with other such persons or with hearing persons via the telephone.

The APSC shall establish the amount to be imposed based on the amount of funding necessary to implement and maintain the System.

The local exchange companies shall collect the surcharge from their customers and transfer the monies collected to a private fund to be held separate from all other funds and used solely for the administration of the System. The fund shall be known as the Dual Party Relay Fund and shall be administered by the Dual Party Relay Fund Board of Trustees.

M. **CONCESSION SERVICE**

1. General

The Telephone Concession Service policy shall apply to all Regular Full-Time employees, Regular Part-Time employees, retirees and employees on long-term disability who reside in the service territory of our operating telephone companies.

2. Regulations

- Regular Full-Time employees receive telephone concession at 100% of the a) eligible expenses. (Regular full-time employees work a scheduled work week of 40 hours or more for a time period of indefinite duration.
- b) Regular Part-Time employees receive telephone concession at 75% of the eligible expenses. (Regular part-time employees work a scheduled work week of at least 30 hours per week, for a time period of indefinite duration.
- c) Retired employees will receive telephone concession at 100% of the eligible expenses.
- Employees on Long-term Disability will continue to receive telephone d) concession at the rate they were before the disability.
- The following items will be reimbursed or covered through billing exemption e) for eligible employees who reside in the service territory of the Company:
 - 1) Basic Residential Service (one line)
 - 2) Custom Calling features
 - 3) End-User Charges interstate and intrastate
 - 4) E-911
 - 5) Dual party relay surcharge
 - 6) Service connection charges
 - 7) Advanced Calling Services





4. Lisman Exchange






