G. Foreign Exchange Service⁽¹⁾

1. General

- a. Foreign Exchange Service is exchange service furnished to a subscriber from a central office of an exchange other than the one that normally serves the area in which the subscriber is located.
- b. Foreign Exchange Service does not come within the Telephone Company's general undertaking, nor does the Telephone Company obligate itself to furnish such service generally; but, will do so where facilities of such a character are available as will permit satisfactory telephone transmission, and where the service is warranted by the circumstances involved.
- c. Foreign Exchange Service may be provided only in connection with private branch exchange trunk lines, and individual line business or residence service. The service will be furnished only at one location or premises for each channel or circuit.

2. Definitions

- a. Foreign Exchange (or FX) Service is exchange (local) service furnished to a subscriber from an exchange other than the one from which he would normally be served. Such service is not in accord with the general plan of furnishing telephone service and such service is furnished only under special conditions, where warranted by the circumstances, including availability of facilities involved.
- b. The exchange in whose service area the customer is located and which furnishes the termination for Foreign Exchange Service Closed-End is called the Local Exchange.
- c. The exchange which provided the central office facilities and furnishes the Foreign Exchange Service Open-End is called the Serving Exchange.
- d. Where Foreign Exchange Service is provided between exchanges of the Company, it is called Intra-Company FX Service. Where such service is furnished between an exchange of the Company and that of another Company, it is called Inter-Company FX Service.

G. Foreign Exchange Service⁽¹⁾ (Continued)

3. Rates

- a. If the Company is the FX Open-End, then the following rate elements will apply:

Local Exchange Access Line (including all applicable surcharges)—Section 2
Voice Grade Interoffice Channel Fixed—Section 10
Voice Grade Interoffice Channel Mileage—Section 10

- b. If the Company is the FX Closed-End, then the following rate elements will apply:

2-Wire Channel Termination—Section 10
Voice Grade Interoffice Channel Fixed—Section 10
Voice Grade Interoffice Channel Mileage—Section 10

- c. All applicable non-recurring charges associated with the provisioning of the rate elements above will apply.

4. Conditions and Limitations

- a. Inter-Company FX Service will be furnished under the terms and conditions of the Foreign Exchange Service Agreement Executed between this Company and the Company involved. This agreement contemplates that:

1. If this company is the Serving Exchange, then this Company will work with the Foreign Exchange Service applicant and the applicant's local exchange company to handle all of the necessary arrangements to establish service.
2. If this Company is the Local Exchange, then this Company will work with the Foreign Exchange Company to establish service.
3. This Company will only bill the customer for its portion of the services/facilities that the Company provides.

5. Directory Listings

- a. A directory listing will be provided for each Foreign Exchange Service in the White Pages of the Telephone Directory of the serving exchange, if this Company is the serving company.
