SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The mileage rates under RATES (1) above are based on the airline distance measured between the customer's primary station and the nearest point on the boundary of the nearest base rate area within the same exchange, and are in addition to the other rates applicable to the service involved.
- 2. The mileage rates in RATES (2) above are applicable in connection with extension or private branch exchange stations and are applicable to the airline distance measured between the terminals of the line involved.
- 3. The Utility will install the necessary wiring from the Utility's side of SNI/PCA of primary station to an off-premises extension SNI/PCA on other customer noncontinuous property for the use of the customer.
- 4. The Utility will install the necessary wiring from the Utility's side of the SNI/PCA of primary station to an off-premises extension SNI/PCA on other noncontinuous property. which is not the customer's premises, provided for the use of customer.
- 5. A residence off-premises extension station on noncontinuous property will not be furnished on a business premise unless it terminates on a telephone answering service
- In this schedule "terminals" means the stations or private branch exchange switchboard 6. to which the off-premises line is connected.
- 7. The line used to serve extension stations is inside wire if:
 - a. the service is entirely on private property; and
 - b. no utility distribution cable facilities are used. The customer shall be responsible for the installation and maintenance of any inside wire and standard jack beyond the Utility's local loop demarcation point.
- 8. Pursuant to Resolution T-16433, two party line service is limited to 15 current customersof-record at the current location-of-record. Requests from these existing two-party line service customers for the following services will not be permitted:
 - a. a transfer of their two-party line service to another name and/or location.
 - b. a reconnection of a disconnected two-party line telephone service for non-payment of a telephone bill.
 - c. a change in service (i.e., request for any custom calling feature activation).
