- 1. The mileage rates in RATES (2) above are applicable in connection with extension or private branch exchange stations located off the premises on which the primary service is located and within the exchange area, in addition to the other rates applicable to those services. The mileage rates apply to airline distance measured between the terminals of the line involved. (T)
- 2. The Utility will install the necessary wiring from the Utility's side of SNI/PCA of primary station to an off-premises extension SNI/PCA on other customer noncontinuous property for the use of the customer. (T)
- 3. The Utility will install the necessary wiring from the Utility's side of the SNI/PCA of primary station to an off-premises extension SNI/PCA on other noncontinuous property, which is not customer premises, provided for the use of customer. (T)
- 4. A residence off-premises extension station on noncontinuous property will not be furnished on a business premise unless it terminates on telephone answering service. (T)
- 5. In this Schedule "terminal" means a station or private branch exchange switchboard to which the off-premises line is connected. (T)
- 6. The line used to serve extension stations is inside wire if: (T)
  - a. the service is entirely on private property; and
  - b. no utility distribution cable facilities are used. The customer shall be responsible for the installation and maintenance of any inside wire and standard jack beyond the Utility's local loop demarcation point.
