APPLICABILITY

Applicable to inter-exchange receiving service.

TERRITORY

Within the exchange areas of all exchanges as said areas are defined on maps filed as part of the tariff schedules.

RATES

Rate per Month

Each inter-exchange receiving service - - - - - \$5.00

RETS

CONDITIONS

1. Inter-exchange receiving service is available to subscribers to business individual line service (except coin box service), business private branch exchange service, or order receiving equipment service in the receiving exchange.
2. A telephone number designation will be assigned to each service subscribed for and will be listed in the Company's telephone directory. Only those calls to this number which originate at stations served by the Company will come within the scope of the service under this schedule and then only when an inter-exchange rate is applicable between the calling station and the service in the receiving exchange.
3. Under this schedule the sent-paid station rate in connection with message toll telephone service is applicable to each inter-exchange message. The subscriber to inter-exchange receiving service will be billed for calls to his number completed in accordance with Condition 2. above.
4. No service connection charge applies in connection with this service.
