Effective January 1, 1987, in accordance with the order of the FCC in Docket (N)  
79105, interior wiring, as defined below, will become the responsibility of  
the customer. The customer will be responsible for the installation and  
maintaining of interior wiring, jacks, and plugs.

Interior Wiring: Wire or cable within a building, from the  
point of entering the building served (where it connects  
with the service connection facility) extending to and  
between instrumentalities, equipment or connecting arrange-  
ments. Interior wiring includes the associated protective  
apparatus; terminal chambers, connecting blocks and frames;  
and the wire or cable between premises of an applicant or  
customer in separate buildings on a continuous property. (N)
