

Rule and Regulation No. 13

TEMPORARY SERVICE

A. Establishment of Temporary Service

The Company will, if no undue hardship to its existing subscribers will result therefrom, furnish temporary service under the following conditions:

1. The applicant will be required to pay to the Company, in advance, the net cost of installing and removing the facilities necessary for furnishing the desired service.
2. Where the duration of service is to be less than one month, the applicant will also be required to deposit a sum of money equal to the estimated bill for the service. If this deposit exceeds the actual bill when known, the excess will be returned to the applicant; if it is less than the actual bill, a bill for the deficit will be presented and collected.
3. Where the duration of service is to exceed one month, the applicant will also be required to establish his credit in the manner prescribed for permanent service.

B. Change to Permanent Status

If a subscriber operates for 36 consecutive months the machinery or equipment for which service was originally established on a temporary basis, and his operations at the end of that time have proven their permanency to the satisfaction of the Company, the payment made pursuant to Section A-1 above will be adjusted to the terms of the extension rule, applicable to permanent service.
