## SPECIAL CONDITIONS - (Continued)

- 2. The Utility will install the necessary wiring from the Utility's side (T) of the SNI/PCA of the primary station to an off-premises extension SNI/PCA on other customer noncontinuous property, or on noncontinuous property which is not customer premises, provided for the use of the customer.
- 3. A residence off-premises extension station on noncontinuous property (T) will not be furnished on business premises unless it terminates on a telephone answering service.
- 4. In this schedule, "terminal" means a station or private branch (T) exchange switchboard to which the off-premises line is connected.
- 5. The line used to serve extension stations is inside wire if: (T)
  - a. the service is entirely on private property; and
  - b. no Utility distribution cable facilities are used. The customer shall be responsible for the installation and maintenance of any inside wire and standard jack beyond the Utility's local loop demarcation point.
