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LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

A. General

1. Basic local telephone service is provided by means of a circuit directly connecting the central office switching equipment with the subscriber's premises to enable the establishment of telephone communications between access lines in the same or different exchanges at the monthly rates contained in this tariff. The facilities used to furnish local telephone service are also used to furnish toll telephone service at rates applicable for such service.
2. The Schedule of Rates as shown on sheet 4 of this Section, have specific rates for the various classes and grades of local exchange service provided in each rate band. The local exchange rates applicable to each exchange are indicated on sheet 5 of this section.
3. Conditions
 - a. The rates set forth in B and C following are for one (1) month period and contemplate telephone facilities regularly provided by the Company and entitle the customer to an unlimited number of telephone calls within the exchange (including EAS points) without additional charge.
 - b. The rates for local exchange service do not include the telephone station set.
 - c. Applicable taxes leveled by state, county and local taxing authorities are added to the rates set forth in this section. (See General Regulations Section 2, Sheet 30).

A. General

1. Total Talk Pack is an optional service package. The package permits a customer to receive services and features for a flat monthly rate, for each Total Talk Pack subscriber line provided. Total Talk Pack includes the following services:¹
 - a. Residential³ or Business⁴ One-Party Line (C)
 - b. Touch Tone
 - c. Three-Way Calling & Call Waiting (Custom Calling Services)
 - d. Caller ID-Name, Anonymous Call Rejection, & Priority Ringing (Advanced Calling Services)
 - e. Caller ID Basic (deregulated service)²
 - f. Inside Wire Protection Plan (deregulated service)²

B. Conditions and Limitations

1. Rules, regulations, and limitations as specified elsewhere in the Company's tariffs for each individual service will apply as part of this bundle.
2. Total Talk Pack customers may terminate their enrollment in the Plan at any time upon notice to the company.
3. Unless terminated by the Total Talk Pack customer or the Company, a customer will remain enrolled in the Plan, as amended from time-to-time, with any applicable changes in rate, for as long as the Plan continues to be offered by the Company.
4. Service Charges, as described in Section 9 of this tariff, apply to requests for new and additional Total Talk Pack lines, and moves of existing lines. Service Charges will not apply when the Total Talk Pack replaces existing Local Exchange Service or if the customer requests a change from the Total Talk Pack back to Local Exchange Service.

2. Customers must sign a one-year contract in order to subscribe to Smart Pack Lite.
3. Customers will incur an early termination fee if they disconnect Smart Pack Lite prior to the end of their one-year commitment.
4. Unless terminated by the Smart Pack Lite customer or the Company, a customer will remain enrolled in the Plan, as amended from time to time, with any applicable changes in rate, for as long as the Plan continues to be offered by the Company.
5. Smart Pack Lite customers are not eligible for discounts or promotional offerings (outside of this bundle) associated with the Custom Calling and Advanced Calling Services included in the Plan, unless specifically provided for in a promotional offering.

SAFETY LINE SERVICE ²

A. General

Safety Line Service is a bundle for residential customers who have their main telecommunications service with a wireless provider but require a basic access line for back-up and high speed data.

The bundle includes a Residential One-Party Line and 1.5 Mbps high speed data.

B. Terms and Conditions

1. Safety Line Service will be provisioned where facilities are available.
2. Rules, regulations, and limitations as specified elsewhere in the Company's tariffs will apply to this bundle.
3. No other optional services or features are allowed with this bundle, except Toll Restriction, Toll Restriction PIN Override, Non-Published Numbers, and Non-Listed Numbers. These four services will be allowed at the rate listed elsewhere in the tariff.
4. Customers must subscribe to this service for 1 year. Cancellation of the bundle prior to the one year timeframe will cause an early termination fee of \$99 to apply.
5. Customers must subscribe to TDS Long Distance Corporation as their long distance provider.
6. Any toll calls will be billed at TDS Long Distance toll rates.
7. Service Connection Charges will not apply.
8. Optional Call plans are not available with this bundle.
9. Seasonal Service is not available with this bundle.

3 STAR Expanded Package (Available in the Clayton & Whitestown Exchanges Only)
Includes: Residential One-Party Line that includes EAS to Indianapolis, Caller ID Deluxe, Call Waiting/Cancel Call Waiting, Call Forwarding, and Preferred Call Forwarding.³

The 3 STAR Packages can be upgraded to include Anonymous Call Rejection, Three-Way Calling, Priority Ringing, Special Call Acceptance, and Personal Voicemail². The charge for this upgrade is set forth in C.2 following.

- b. 4 STAR Standard Package (All exchanges except Clayton & Whitestown)
Includes: Residential One-Party Line, Caller ID Deluxe, Call Waiting/Cancel Call Waiting, Call Forwarding, Preferred Call Forwarding, Anonymous Call Rejection, and 300 Minutes of TDS Long Distance¹ calling.

4 STAR Expanded Package (Clayton & Whitestown Exchanges Only)
Includes: Residential One-Party Line that includes EAS to Indianapolis, Caller ID Deluxe, Call Waiting/Cancel Call Waiting, Call Forwarding, Preferred Call Forwarding, Anonymous Call Rejection, and 300 Minutes of TDS Long Distance¹ calling.

5 STAR Expanded Package (Clayton & Whitestown Exchanges Only)
Includes: Residential One-Party Line that includes EAS to Indianapolis, Caller ID Deluxe, Call Waiting/Cancel Call Waiting, Call Forwarding, 3-Way Calling, Anonymous Call Rejection, Priority Ringing, Special Call Acceptance, Preferred Call Forwarding, Personal Voice Mail,² and Unlimited TDS Long Distance¹ calling.

3. Unless terminated by the STAR Package customer or the Company, a customer will remain enrolled in the Package, as amended from time-to-time, with any applicable changes in rate, for as long as the Plan continues to be offered by the Company.
4. New Customers that subscribe to one of the STAR Packages will receive a waiver of all installation charges.

Service Charges will not apply when the STAR Package replaces existing Local Exchange Service or if the customer requests a change from the STAR Package back to Local Exchange Service.

5. STAR Package customers are not eligible for discounts or promotional offerings outside of this Package, unless specifically provided for in a promotional offering.
6. The Package may not be combined with any other optional toll calling plan service, except for those specified in this offering.
7. Customers may upgrade their Voice Mail Service package for an additional fee.
8. Customers who fail to pay the entire Package rate per month will have all STAR Package optional features removed. The customer will then be converted to the tariffed Basic Local service rate. Service Charges will not apply for converting services back to tariff rates. Such customers will not be permitted to re-enroll in this any of the Packages until such time as all associated unpaid balances are satisfactorily paid in full.

LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

END USER ACCESS SERVICE

A. General

The Telephone Company will provide End User Service (End User Access) to end users who obtain local exchange service from the Telephone Company under its general and/or local exchange tariffs.

1. End User Access provides for the use of an End User Common Line (EUCL).

B. Limitations

1. A telephone number is not provided with End User Access.
2. Detail billing is not provided with End User Access.
3. Directory listings are not included with End User Access.
4. Intercept arrangements are not included with End User Access.

C. Undertaking of the Telephone Company

The Telephone Company will provide use of an End User Access at rates and charges as set forth in G. following, as follows:

1. Use of an EUCL by an end user, in connection with intrastate Access Services, is provided under this tariff. Such use will be provided when the end user obtains local exchange service.
2. The Telephone Company will be responsible for contacts and arrangements with customers for the billing of End User Access charges.

LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

END USER ACCESS SERVICE (Continued)

D. Obligations of the End User

1. When the end user is a Radio Common Carrier (RCC), or a Maritime Radio Common Carrier (MRCC), it shall designate whether the local exchange services it is provided by the Telephone Company are used as access lines for its services or used as administrative lines.
2. When the end user is provided with a local exchange service, which is not identified as Centrex, Business or Residence service, it shall provide the Telephone Company any requested information necessary for the Telephone Company to determine the appropriate charges.

E. Payment Arrangements and Credit Allowances

1. Minimum Period

The minimum period for which EUCL End User Access is provided to an end user and for which charges are applicable is the same as that in the general and/or local exchange tariffs for the associated local exchange service.

2. Cancellation of Applications

End User Access is canceled when the order for the associated local telephone exchange service is canceled. No cancellation charges apply.

LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

END USER ACCESS SERVICE (Continued)

E. Payment Arrangements and Credit Allowances (Continued)

3. Changes to Orders

When changes are made to orders for the local exchange service, associated with End User Access, any necessary changes will be made for End User Access. No charges will apply.

4. Allowance for Interruptions

When there is an interruption to an EUCL, requested End User Access credit allowances for interruptions will be provided as set forth for credit allowance for interruptions in 2.4.4 preceding.

5. Temporary Suspension of Service

When an end user temporarily suspends its local exchange service which is associated with EUCL, one-half of the EUCL per month charge will be temporarily suspended for the time period the local exchange service is suspended.

F. Rate Regulations

1. EUCL per month charges will be billed to the end user of the associated Local Exchange Service.
2. For each local exchange service provided as remote call forwarding residential service or remote call forwarding business service under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, End User Access charges do not apply.

For each local exchange service, other than local exchange service used for administrative purposes, provided to Radio Common Carriers and/or Maritime Radio Common carriers as access lines for their services under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, End User Access charges do not apply.

F. Rate Regulations (Continued)

3. When an end user is provided more than one local business exchange service in a state by the same Telephone Company, other than that specified in 2. preceding, and when the local business exchange service is provided as paystation service under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, the End User Common Line (EUCL) Multiline Business Subscriber-Individual Line or trunk rate as set forth in G.3. following applies to each such paystation local business exchange service.
4. When an end user is provided more than one local business exchange service in a state by the same Telephone Company, other than that 1 specified in 2. preceding, and when the local business exchange service is provided under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs and is not covered by 1.2. and 3. preceding, the end User Common Line (EUCL)-Multiline Business Subscriber-Individual Line or trunk rate as set forth in G.3. following applies to each such local business exchange service.
5. When an end user is provided a single local business exchange service in a state by the same Telephone Company, other than that specified in 2. preceding, and when the local business exchange service is provided as a multiparty service under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, each party is deemed to be a user of an EUCL and the End User Common Line (EUCL) Single Line Subscriber-Individual Line or trunk rate as set forth in G.2. following applies to each such party.
6. When an end user is provided a single local business exchange service in a state by the same Telephone Company other than that specified in 2. preceding, and when the local business exchange service is provided under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, the End User Common Line (EUCL) Single Line Subscriber-Individual Line or trunk rate as set forth in G.2. following applies to each single business service. Such local business exchange service includes a single paystation business service or any other single local business exchange service not covered in 6. preceding.
7. Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) Services
 - a. ISDN Basic Rate Interface (BRI)

When an end user is provided residence or business local exchange service under any general and/or local exchange service tariff(s) using an Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) Basic Rate Interface (BRI) arrangement, one (1) EUCL Residence – Individual line or trunk charge as set forth in Section G.1, following, or, one (1) EUCL Single Line Business – Individual line or trunk charge as set forth in Section G.2, following, applies to each ISDN BRI arrangement.
 - b. ISDN Primary Rate Interface (PRI)

When an end user is provided residence or business local exchange service under any general and/or local exchange service tariff(s) using an Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) Primary Rate Interface (PRI) arrangement, five (5) EUCL – Multiline Business Individual line or trunk charges as set forth in Section G.3, following, apply to each ISDN PRI arrangement.

8. Digital Transport Service (DTS)

PAYSTATION SERVICE

A. General

Paystation Service provides telephone service to a customer-leased or owned paystation with or without coin collecting devices. A Paystation Access Line permits providers of such service to provide pay telephone service to the public.

B. Definitions

Coin Supervision - Provides signaling capability from the central office for paystations that do not have signaling capability within the telephone. This signaling capability provides operators and/or operator systems coin control.

Customer - For the purposes of this tariff, the customer is the Paystation Service Provider.

Network Interface Device - A company-provided jack or its equivalent. It is the point of connection between the Company owned wiring and wiring owned by the customer. For the purposes of this tariff, the network interface device will be installed at a location mutually agreed upon by the customer and the Company.

Originating Line Screening (OLS) - Enables operator service providers to determine whether there are billing restrictions on the exchange access line from which a call originates. OLS service delivers codes on operator assisted calls to identify calls originating from privately owned paystations, inmate locations, and hotels/motels, etc. Rates for this service are found in the appropriate interstate access tariff, when facilities and service are available.

Paystation Access Line - A basic coin transmission dial tone line. It is a line side connection from the local exchange switch to the point of demarcation at the customer premises.

Selective Class of Call Screening - Enables the customer to restrict outgoing operator-handled calls, placed over the Company's network, from the service point to only those calls which are charged to a called telephone, a third number or a calling card. Selective Class of Call Screening will be provided at the customer's option, where such facilities are available.
