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#### A. Application of Tariff

This Tariff applies to Directory Assistance Service furnished in Michigan by Shiawassee Telephone Company, hereinafter referred to as the Company.

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#### General Α.

Directory Assistance Service gives customers access to telephone numbers of individuals or businesses by dialing 555-1212, 4-1-1 or 1-4-1-1.

#### **Definitions** B.

- Local numbers are any NPA/NXXs within the customer's local calling area or 1. home NPA.
- National numbers are any NPA/NXXs within the United States, Canada, 2. Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, but outside the customer's local calling area or home NPA.
- Call Completion is when a customer requests that a call be completed to the 3. number that was provided during the directory assistance call.

#### C. Regulations

- A maximum of two requested telephone numbers is allowed per call. 1.
- Rates will apply based on the NPA/NXX requested. 2.

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# **DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE SERVICE (Continued)**

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## E. Exemptions

- **(T)**
- Residence and business service (including a Centrex or AIOD equipped PBX station) are exempt from the charge and allowance portions of the Directory Assistance Service plan when a user (or the principal user of a business service) is unable to use a telephone directory because of physical or mental limitations.
- To obtain an exemption, the customer provides the name, address, telephone number and nature of the limitation for the individual requiring the exemption. A certificate of Directory Assistance Charge Exemption is required for each residence or business line to be exempted.
- 3. Information contained on the exemption certificate will be treated as confidential by the Company.
- 4. The customer shall notify the Company when the need for an exemption no longer exists.

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
