#### CONDITIONS

- Only one party service is offered where facilities are available. Existing multi-party service is grandfathered until one party service is available. Multiparty service will only be offered to new customers if one party service is not available. All multi-party service will automatically be upgraded to one party service with thirty days notice to the customer when facilities are available. All one party service includes touch calling.
- 2. The number of parties on a multi-party line will be (C) limited to four.
- 3. The above services and rates include extended area service between all exchanges of the Utility.
- 4. Exchange service is provided through facilities owned and maintained by the Utility and according to standards of the Utility. The territories served are shown on area maps (see "Map of Exchange Areas" in this tariff) filed with the Commission. These territories are referred to as "Exchanges". Within each exchange is a "Base Rate" area and "Suburban" area.
- 5. The application of business or residence rates is determined by the actual or obvious use made of the service by the subscriber. Where only one telephone is provided at a location which is both business and residence, the business rate will apply.
- 6. Flat rate exchange service will not be installed on premises of a public or semi-public nature in a location where the telephone would be accessible for use by the patrons of the subscriber or by the public in general.

#### **CONDITIONS (CONTINUED)**

- 7. Exchange access line rates include the capability to call without application of a toll charge to any other telephone located in an exchange of the Utility.
- 8. Connection of Customer-provided Telephones: A subscriber to business or residence local exchange service may connect

A subscriber to business or residence local exchange service may connect telephones provided him to his telephone company exchange line. Telephones furnished by the subscriber shall be compatible to telephone company equipment. Party line customers shall be required to equip customer owned telephones with proper ringers. All maintenance of customer-provided telephone instruments shall by the responsibility of the subscriber.

9. The number of telephone instruments on a line may be limited under certain circumstances to maintain a satisfactory service quality standard determined by the company.

## SCHEDULE 1 EXCHANGE SERVICE



- A. General
  - Remote Call Forwarding (RCF) is a service whereby a call placed from station (the originating station) to a Remote Call Forwarding telephone number in one exchange (the call forwarding location) is automatically forwarded by Company central office equipment to another station designated by the RCF customer (the terminating station). This service is offered subject to availability of suitable facilities. Where the call forwarding location is in a multi-office exchange, the Company will determine the serving central office.
  - 2. Remote Call Forwarding is provided on the condition that the customer subscribe to sufficient RCF features and facilities to adequately handle calls to the FCF customer without interfering with or impairing any services offered by the Company.
- B. Conditions
  - A Non-recurring Service Order Charge and a Non-recurring Central Office work charge as shown in Schedule 7 of this Tariff will apply to each request for Remote Call Forwarding or to each request for a change in the forwarding destination. Applicable long distance charges will apply to each call forwarded outside the local exchange area.


