Conditions:

1. A business line shall be connected to a PBX only when the subscriber provides assurance that each station location can be identified by a public service answering point (PSAP) receiving a 9-1-1 call from that station. Identification includes physical address location as well as telephone number. Such assurance can be provided either by the subscriber providing written assurance that the PBX has the built-in capability to provide the station location identification or by use of additional business lines provided by the company and paid for by the subscriber at normal tariffed rates. If the latter is used to provide the station location identification, it shall be the subscriber's responsibility to provide the station location identification information and any changes or updates thereto directly to the PSAP or the administrator of the master street address guide. In any event, if any station location is not equipped with direct inward dialing, the subscriber shall post that station with a notice that dialing 9-1-1 does not provide location identification to the answering party.


2. Base charges named in this schedule include extended service between and among the Amboy, Cougar, La Center, and Yale exchanges and between the Amboy and Yacolt exchanges. (T)

3. Applicable taxes levied by federal, state, county and local taxing authorities are added to the rates set forth in this section.

4. Local exchange service is provided only to premises which evidence permanent occupancy by an occupancy permit or at least two other county or city issued permits for water, power, sewage disposal, or natural gas distribution. (N)

Conditions: (Continued)

5. Unless facilities or operating conditions limit the availability of the service, each subscriber must subscribe to Option A, Option B or Option C. During the first six months of service, a customer who subscribes to one option may switch to another option without paying a non-recurring charge. For any change of option subsequent to the first change of option made within the first six months of service and for any change made after the first six months of service, the non-recurring charge for a service order Schedule 3 shall apply.
6. The Charges Per Call are for Extended Area Service between the following exchanges: (1) LaCenter to Vancouver, Battle Ground, Ridgefield, Yacolt, and Woodland; (2) Amboy to Battle Ground and Vancouver; (3) Yale to Woodland; and (4) Cougar to Woodland.
7. Extended Area Service for those routes described in Condition 7 shall be terminated upon approval of separate schedules which may be submitted by the Company in the future. The Company will file for an approval of another Extended Area Service schedule if the Community Calling Fund or a similar fund is created and funded or if other conditions develop which make such a filing warranted. In such an event, there shall be no "grandfather" rights to continued Extended Area Service under this schedule.
8. Call Detail EAS allows subscribers to receive a detailed bill of all EAS calls for EAS routes. Billing detail depicts each such EAS call by number called.
9. Second Line EAS Restriction allows the customer to restrict a second line against making EAS calls.
10. No service non-recurring charge shall apply for any change or move to or from Option A, B or C during the first ninety days following the date this sheet takes effect.
