Schedule 3

CARRIER COMMON LINE ACCESS SERVICE - CONDITIONS

Applicability:

1. Carrier Common Line Access Service permits the use of the Local Exchange Company's common lines for access to end users by customers in connection with the provision of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services.

2. Carrier Common Line Access Service is provided where the customer obtains Switched Access Service from the Local Exchange Company or where the customer is engaged in the provision of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services pursuant to agreement with the Local Exchange Company.

3. Premium Access is:

(a) Switched Access Service which is provided under the Local Exchange Company's access service tariff filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission and which is equal in quality to that available to AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc.; and

(b) Switched Access Service in an end office converted to equal access.

4. Non Premium Access is Switched Access Service which is provided in an end office not yet converted to equal access and which is not equal in quality to that available to AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc.

Limitations:

1. A telephone number is not provided with Carrier Common Line Access Service.

2. Detail billing is not provided with Carrier Common Line Access Service.

3. Directory listings are not included in the rates and charges for Carrier Common Line Access Service.

4. Intercept arrangements are not included in the rates and charges for Carrier Common Line Access Service.

5. All line side communications provided in the same combined access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.

6. All trunk side connections provided in the same combined access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.

7. All line side communications provided to a customer in a hunt group must be of the same type (e.g., all MTS/WATS or all FX type).

8. Where Switched Access Services are connected with Special Access Services at the Telephone Company Designated WATS Serving Offices for the provision of WATS or WATS-type Services, Switched Access Service minutes which are carried on that end of the service (i.e., originating minutes for outward WATS and WATS-type services and terminating minutes for inward WATS and WATS-type services) shall not be assessed Carrier Common Line Access per minute charges.

Rate Regulations:

1. Rate Definitions. The following rates apply to all customers furnished Carrier Common Line Access Service pursuant to this tariff for all feature groups offered by the Local Exchange Company:

(a) Premium Access Rate. A rate per access minute of use for Premium Access as defined in Section A.3 of this Schedule 3. This rate will be billed by the Local Exchange Company based on actual usage of the customer or the assume usage of the customer when measurement capabilities are not available.

(b) Non-Premium Access Rate. A rate per access minute of use for Non-Premium Access as defined in Section A.4 of this Schedule 3. This rate will be billed by the Local Exchange Company based on actual usage of the Customer or the assumed usage of the Customer when measurement capabilities are not available.

(c) Universal Service Fund Rate. A rate per access minute of use for Premium Access and Non-Premium Access as defined in Section A.3 and A.4 of this Schedule 3. This rate is designed to provide assistance to high cost companies in order to help preserve Universal Service. This rate will be billed by the Local Exchange Company based on actual usage of the customer or the assumed usage of the customer when measurement capabilities are not available.

2. Application of Rates.

(a) The terminating Premium Access and/or Non-Premium Access, per minute charge(s) apply to all terminating access minutes of use, plus all originating access minutes of use associated with calls placed at 700, 800 and 900-type numbers, plus all originating access minutes of use associated with Feature Group A (FGA) Access Services where the off-hook supervisory signalling is forwarded by the customer's equipment when the called party answers. These rates will be billed by the Local Exchange Company based on actual usage of the customer or the assumed usage of the customer when measurement capabilities are not available.

(b) The originating Premium Access and/or Non-Premium Access, per minute charge(s) apply to all originating access minutes of use, less those originating access minutes of use associated with calls placed to 700, 800 and 900-type numbers and less those originating access minutes of use associated with FGA Access Services where the off-hook supervisory signalling is forwarded by the Customer's equipment when the called party answers. These rates will be billed by the Local Exchange Company based on actual usage of the Customer or the assumed usage of the Customer when measurement capabilities are not available.
