LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICES

5.1 BASIC LOCAL EXCHANGE ACCESS SERVICE

A. General

Basic Local Exchange Access Service (BLEAS) provides a customer with one or more analog, voice grade telephone communications channel that connects the customer premises equipment to the Company's switching equipment (access line). The communication channel is used to place or receive a call using the public switch network located at the Company's Central Office. This also allows customers to have access to interexchange services.

B. Service Descriptions

1) Auxiliary Access Line (2ND Line)

Auxiliary Line refers to an access line that is subscribed to by a residence customer, which is in addition to the primary access line.

2) Key Access Line

Key Access Line refers to an access line that is connected to a key telephone at the customer premises. Key telephones allow all incoming calls to be redirected by an operator to the appropriate station by pressing the desired button on the key telephone.

3) One-Party

One-Party means each customer has their own communication channel between the switching equipment and the customer's premises. It is not shared with any other customer.

4) Primary Access Line (1ST Line)

Primary Access Line is the first or main telephone communication channel between the Company's switching equipment and the customer's premises that is subscribed to by a customer.

5) PBX Trunk

PBX Trunk is a communications medium between the Company's switching equipment and the switching equipment (PBX) at the customer's premises.

C. Conditions and Limitations

- 1) The rate for one-party auxiliary Residence service is available to one-party Residence subscribers on the same premises as their primary access line.
- 2) Hearing impaired customers who are able and choose to use 2-line Voice Carry Over shall not be charged any intrastate non-recurring charge or monthly rate for the second line.
- 3) Message rate charges on measured local plans will not apply to calls to the company business office, repair center, Emergency 911 Service, or for Long Distance calls.
- 4) Detailed billing on measured plans may be provided by the local company. If available, this service must be ordered prior to the commencement of the billing period for which the billing detail is requested.

D. Rate Application

- 1) Local calling may be offered on a flat rate or measured basis.
 - a) Flat Rate Basis: All calls originating and terminating within the local calling area are included in the rate.
 - b) Measure Rate Basis: All calls originating and terminating within the local calling area are billed at a per message or per minute rate.
- 2) Rates for Basic Local Exchange Access service are billed monthly and on a per line or per trunk basis. Service Charges specified in Section 4 will apply.

5.2 EXTENDED AREA SERVICE (EAS)

A. General

Extended Area Service (EAS) allows a customer in one exchange to call a customer in another exchange without incurring toll charges. The EAS exchange(s) then become a part of the local calling area.

B. Rate Application

Rates for Extended Area Service are billed monthly on a per line or per trunk basis. The rate may be included in the BLEAS rates.

5.3 EXTENDED COMMUNITY CALLING SERVICE (ECC)

A. General

Extended Community Calling (ECC) Service provides for the completion of local messages between a customer located in an Exchange operated by the Company and customers located in different Exchanges in accordance with the regulations and rates set forth in the following.

B. Scope

Except as provided in each company's tariff, the ECC area for a Company Exchange consists of all other Exchanges within the State of Wisconsin within the same LATA, including those of other Local Exchange Companies, not included in the Extended Area Service area of the Exchange, that are either adjacent to the Exchange or are within 15 airline miles of the exchange.

C. Rate Application⁽¹⁾

(C)

- 1) Rates for ECC Messages consist of a charge per minute. The per minute charge applies for each minute with a fraction of a minute being charged as a full minute of call duration. Call duration begins when the connection is established between the calling party and the called party. Call duration ends when the calling party hangs up thereby releasing the network connection. If the called party hangs up, but the calling party does not, call duration ends when the network connection is released by either automatic timing equipment in the telephone network or by the Operator.
- Customers will receive an itemized list of their ECC calls with their monthly telephone bill with a summary page showing the total minutes and total charge.
- 3) Extended Community Calling Service is not available for WATS, 800, and Cellular Service.

(1) ECC calls are included at no charge when a customer chooses a Total Talk Unlimited plan.

5.4 LIFELINE PROGRAM

A. Description

Lifeline is a program designed to provide telephone service at a monthly discounted rate to low income customers, as defined in s. PSC 160, Wis. Adm. Code. Lifeline rates are established according to s. PSC 160 and Wis. Adm. Code and are available to all qualified low-income customers. Extended Community Calling (ECC) Service is not included in Lifeline Service.

B. Conditions and Limitations

- 1) The Lifeline Program is available only to qualifying low-income residential customers with a single telephone line per household.
- 2) Customers may not be disconnected from Lifeline service for non-payment of toll charges.
- 3) Call Blocking Services, as described in Section IX of this tariff, are available at no charge to Lifeline customers.
- 4) Local service deposit requirements will be waived for customers who voluntarily receive Toll Blocking.
- 5) Participation in the specified programs must be verified by the telephone company through the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS)/Division of Medicaid Services (DMS), Department's Client Assistance for Re-employment and Economic Support (CARES) database or completing an application and providing proof of eligibility documents.
- 6) Customers shall complete and remit any query authorization forms or forfeit eligibility. Verification of eligibility will be deemed to be the finding of the Social Security Number (SSN) and name of the listed customer in the active records of CARES for at least one of the specified income assistance programs.
- 7) Reconfirmation of eligibility for Lifeline Service will be done at least once each year
- 8) Credits will appear on an eligible Customer's bill on the bill date next following the date of application for the Lifeline Program. In cases where a Customer's eligibility date as found in CARES records precedes the last bill date prior to application, credit will also be given on one month's prior bill.

5.5 **VOICE CARRY OVER**

A. General

Two-line Voice Carry Over (VCO) makes it possible for a person who is deaf or hard of hearing and a person who is hearing to communicate with each other over telecommunications services.

B. Description

This service requires two access lines where one of the access lines has three-way calling installed. The deaf or hard of hearing person reads what the hearing person says on one telephone line (the relay operator uses this line to type on the TTY). The deaf or hard of hearing and hearing person talk to each other on the other telephone line (the relay operator listens only).

C. Regulations and Conditions

The obligation to file this tariff, and the charges and conditions under which the service described herein are provided, are to be the subject of a request to the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin for a declamatory ruling on the application and validity of several provisions of Wis. Adm. Code Ch. PSC 160. The Company reserves the right:

- 1) to modify this tariff,
- 2) to discontinue or modify the conditions under which the service described herein are provided; and
- 3) to modify the charges for the service described herein, effective as of the date such service is provided

5.6 PAYSTATION SERVICE

A. General

Paystation Service provides basic local exchange telephone service via analog, voice grade channels to a customer-leased or owned paystation. The Paystation may or may not have coin collecting devices. A Paystation Access Line permits providers of such service to provide pay telephone service to the public.

B. Definitions

Coin Supervision

Provides signaling capability from the central office for paystations that do not have signaling capability within the telephone. This signaling capability provides operators and/or operator systems coin control.

Customer

For the purposes of this tariff, the customer is the Paystation Service Provider.

Network Interface Device

A company-provided jack or its equivalent. It is the point of connection between the Company owned wiring and wiring owned by the customer. For the purposes of this tariff, the network interface device will be installed at a location mutually agreed upon by the customer and the Company.

Originating Line Screening (OLS)

Enables operator service providers to determine whether there are billing restrictions on the exchange access line from which a call originates. OLS service delivers codes on operator assisted calls to identify calls originating from privately owned paystations, inmate locations, and hotels/motels, etc. Rates for this service are found in the appropriate interstate access tariff, when facilities and service are available.

Paystation Access Line

A basic coin transmission dial tone line. It is a line side connection from the local exchange switch to the point of demarcation at the customer premisess.

Selective Class of Call Screening

Enables the customer to restrict outgoing operator-handled calls, placed over the Company's network, from the service point to only those calls which are charged to a called telephone, a third number or a calling card. Selective Class of Call Screening will be provided at the customer's option, where such facilities are available.

- The Company reserves the right to disconnect service when the customer does 10) not comply with the F.C.C. and state rules and regulations related to paystation service and equipment.
- 11) The Multiline Business Subscriber Line Charge, found in the interstate access tariff, is applicable to all paystation access lines.
- 12) Installation, move and change charges will be those applicable to business service.
- 13) Non-Published Number charges do not apply to Paystation Service.

1) Description

- a) Foreign Exchange Service (FXCB) is a Network Access Line Service furnished from a Central Office of an exchange other than the exchange normally serving the area in which the customer is located.
- b) Foreign Exchange Service may be furnished between two exchanges of the same company or between the exchanges of two different companies within a LATA and within the state, when the other company is willing to concur in arrangements for the furnishing of such service. In those cases where a portion of the service is furnished by another company, the rates and regulations of the other company apply to the part of the service it furnishes.

2) Conditions and Limitations

- a) Foreign Exchange Service will be provided between exchanges through facilities the Company deems most economical.
- b) If special construction is required construction charges in Section 10 apply.
- c) Foreign Exchange Service customers have the same Basic Exchange Services and Local Calling Area, the same rates for Message Toll Service and the same Rules and Regulations as apply in the foreign exchange from which the service is furnished.
- d) Foreign Exchange Service is prohibited: 1) between exchanges located within each company's defined Local Calling Area, and 2) between exchanges that are located within each company's Extended Area Service (EAS) or Extended Community Calling (ECC) Areas.
- e) FX is not available in connection with Paystation service.

3) Rate Application

The rates for Foreign Exchange service are in addition to the normal Local rates for the Class of Service furnished to the Customer in the serving foreign exchange.

- d) Extension/Station Line service may not be provided with Centrex Service.
- E Extension/Station Line service terminations must be located where use can be restricted to those entitled to use of the Customer's service.
- F Extension/Station Line service will be provided between exchanges through facilities the Company deems most economical.

A. **GENERAL**

Safety Line Service is a bundle for residential customers who have their main telecommunications service with a wireless provider but require a basic access line for back-up and high speed data.

The bundle includes a Residential One-Party Line and 1.5 Mbps high speed data.

B. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Safety Line Service will be provisioned where facilities are available.
- 2. Rules, regulations, and limitations as specified elsewhere in the Company's tariffs will apply to this bundle.
- No other optional services or features are allowed with this bundle, except Toll Restriction, Toll Restriction PIN Override, Non-Published Numbers and Non Listed Numbers. These four services will be allowed at the rate listed elsewhere in the tariff.
- 4. Customers must subscribe to this service for 1 year. Cancellation of the bundle prior to the one year timeframe will cause an early termination fee of \$99 to apply.
