CONCURRENCE WITH OTHER COMPANY TARIFFS

15.1 SERVICES

A. Universal Emergency Number Service

The Company concurs in the rates, rules and regulations governing intrastate Universal Emergency Number Service as filed by AT&T/Wisconsin Bell, Inc. with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin under tariff P.S.C. of WI 20 (Part 8) unless specified under 15.3 below.

B. Foreign Exchange Service¹

The Company concurs in the rates, rules and regulations governing intrastate Exchange Access Services provided by AT&T Wisconsin in their Guidebook (Part 4) residing on AT&T's website unless specified under 15.3 below.

C. Dedicated Communication Services²

The Company concurs in the rates, rules and regulations governing intrastate Dedicated Communications Services provided by AT&T Wisconsin in their Guidebook (Part 15) residing on AT&T's website unless specified under 15.3 below.

D. Private Line Service (interexchange only)

The Company concurs in the terms and conditions of the Company's Interstate Special Access Tariff, together with amendments and successive issues, for the purpose of providing Private Lines Services between exchanges within the LATA unless specified under 15.3 below. Services are not available at all locations. Rates will be listed separately in each Company's specific section.

15.2 CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS

- A. Requests for the above listed services will be furnished insofar as the ability and facilities available of the Company permit
- B. The Company extends the concurrences with AT&T/Wisconsin Bell to subsequent changes made to the Tariff or Guidebook as stated above.
- C. The Company hereby expressly reserves the right to cancel and make void any portion of the concurrence statements listed above at any and such time as it appears that such cancellation is to the best interest of Telephone Company.
- D. Other local service charges from the Company may apply for Foreign Exchange (Company Dial Tone Service) and E911.

15.2 <u>CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS (Cont'd)</u>

- E. Construction charges apply on Foreign Exchange Service for any portion of (T) (M) construction necessary within the serving central office area. Foreign exchange customers are required to pay for all necessary construction from their premises to the exchange boundary of the serving central office.
- F. Requests for concurring services will be limited to those not offered in the Company's (T) local tariff and up to speeds of 44.736 Mbps. Services for speeds greater than 44.736 (C) Mbps may be handled on ICB contracts.
- G. Foreign Exchange Service will not be provided to an exchange or another telephone (T) company wherein Extended Area Service is presently provided and which exchange does not offer "Flat Rate Business Service" within its local calling area. (M)
- H. Cross Boundary Foreign Exchange is prohibited between exchanges that are located (T) within each Company's Extended Area Service (EAS) or Extended Community Calling (ECC) areas.
